

NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

FOR AS LITTLE AS \$1,000 YOU CAN HAVE YOUR NAME ON A PIECE OF OTTAWA LITTLE THEATRE.

NAME YOUR SEAT \$1,000

A plaque with your name is mounted on the seat and in a public location.

NAME ON A ROW \$10,000

A plaque with your name is mounted on the two seats facing the aisles and in a public location (a row has approx. 14 seats).

NAME THE WHEELCHAIR CIRCLE \$25,000

A plaque with your name is mounted at entrances to the Wheelchair Circle.

NAME THE UPPER LOBBY \$50,000

Your name mounted on the wall in the lobby.

NAME THE BESSERER STREET ENTRANCE \$75,000

Your name mounted above the Besserer Street doors inside the theatre. For an additional \$25,000, your name is mounted above the Besserer Street doors outside the theatre as well.

NAME THE AUDITORIUM \$300,000

Your name mounted above the auditorium doors in the lobby of the theatre. For an additional \$200,000, your name could be mounted on the outside of the building as well.

OLT's current building opened in 1972 and remains a sound, vibrant asset to the community. Necessary repairs have been split into four "ACTS" to be completed over five years as the necessary funds are raised. Ottawa Little Theatre is happy to report that ACTS I, II, and III are nearing completion and we are now entering the final act – **ACT IV: Accessibility and Auditorium Renovations Campaign**, providing improved accessibility and comfort to our patrons.



ACT I: SOUND AND STAGE IMPROVEMENTS **COMPLETE** \$204,000

Enhance the quality of our productions, improve safety features and modernize our stage equipment.

ACTS II & III: EXTERIOR REPAIRS AND ROOF **COMPLETE** \$535,000

Ensure the building remains structurally sound by repairing its exterior shell and reduce power requirements by "building green" for a sustainable future.

REPLACE FLY-TOWER SIDING **TO BE COMPLETED** \$80,000

INTERIOR RENOVATIONS AND ACCESSIBILITY **SUMMER 2017**

Make public areas more accessible and renovate service areas to better serve our patrons, volunteers and visitors.

SCENE 1 \$255,000

Replace the 45 year old seats and reconfigure the seating in the main auditorium to:

- Provide new wheelchair seating
- Improve the comfort and sightlines of all patrons

SCENE 2 \$75,000

Install acoustic fittings and repaint auditorium.

SCENE 3 \$15,000

Redesign Besserer Street entrance to improve accessibility.

SCENE 4 \$5,000

Redesign Besserer Street washroom to improve accessibility.

SCENE 5 **COMPLETE** \$13,000

Replace Hearing Assist System with modern system. COMPLETED THANKS TO DR. J. KENNETH AND MARGARET TORRANCE

SCENE 6 \$49,000

Replace HVAC System

SCENE 7 \$56,000

Lobby décor and kitchen renovations
