#### **Director's Notes**

Welcome back to theatre! The last 2 years have been hard on all of us for so many different reasons. I hope that your return to live theatre gives you something to feel optimistic about - something akin to normalcy perhaps.

Our show Burn has been on quite a journey. We began rehearsals in 2019 and we made it all the way to our Preview performance before lockdown in March of 2020. We thought it would be a few weeks, then a few months, and now it's been a few years. As the pandemic evolved, we saw the opportunity to regroup and turn the stage lights back on in December 2021. I am excited to say that we are planning to bring Burn to the largest arts festival in the world this August - the Edinburgh Fringe Festival. We hope that you can participate in some of the events we have planned as fundraisers throughout the run of the show; and that you will follow us on social media as we travel there.

Over the years John has performed in eleven OLT productions including Dangerous Liaisons, Drinking Alone, Emerald City, Wrong Turn at Lungfish and Greetings to name a few, and in 2011 directed The Long Weekend by Norm Foster, where it picked up several awards. John has also performed and produced shows elsewhere, such as the Gladstone, in shows such as David Mamet's Glengarry Glen Ross (Best Production 2015 Capital Critics Awards), and Speed-The-Plow (Outstanding Male Actor nomination Prix Rideau Awards, Best Actor nomination Capital Critics Circle Awards) and most recently in his own award-winning play An Act of Grace. In addition to Ottawa theatre work, John also worked in television in Toronto for six years and was an original cast member of Second City's Tony & Tina's Wedding in Toronto, where he played various characters in over 650 performances. A member of ACTRA, The Canadian Actors Equity Association and the Playwrights Guild of Canada, John is a proud recipient of the Audrey Ashley Award for longstanding dedication to the Ottawa theatre community.

Nominated as Best New Play of 2017, Burn has since been, and continues to be, produced across Canada, and the US, and this March saw its UK debut. An Act of Grace, John's second play, was Ottawa Little Theatre's entry at the Eastern Ontario Drama League Festival in 2018 and was awarded Best Production, Best Ensemble, The People's Choice Award and the Adjudicators Award for Outstanding Achievement in Playwriting. Having Burn produced at OLT is particularly special for John seeing as his mother, Jean, acted on this very stage in the 1950's. Having *Burn* come home to OLT is one of his life's great moments.


